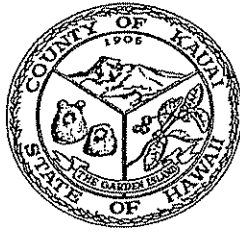

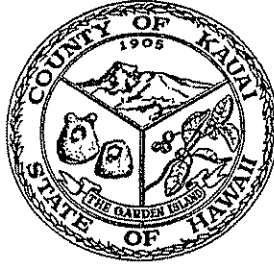
1. Will reservations continue unabated?

SUBJECT: USE OF PUBLIC FACILITIES ON FURLOUGH DAYS

Dear Chairman Asing and Members of the County Council:

This is in response to your request dated June 17, 2010 as it relates to the County's Furlough Plan that will be effective on July 1, 2010.

I. Kaua'i War Memorial Convention Hall; Neighborhood Centers, and Park Pavilions:

1. Will reservations continue unabated?
  - a) No. Reservations for Kaua'i Memorial Convention Hall, Neighborhood Centers and Park Pavilions will not be accepted for furlough Friday's.
2. Will regularly scheduled activities at the neighborhood centers be impacted?
  - a) Yes
3. Will County facilities be restricted from use by the public on furlough days?
  - a) Yes. Secured facilities such as the War Memorial Convention Hall, Neighborhood Centers and Stadiums will not be available to the public on furlough days.

b) No. Open parks, pavilions, tennis courts and basketball courts will be available on a first come first serve basis.

4. Will the schedule for the Kapa'a Pool be changed for furlough days? Yes
5. Will both the Waimea Pool and Kapa'a Pool be open on furlough days? No
