**COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE/INTERGOVERNMENTAL
RELATIONS COMMITTEE**

April 2, 2008

- b) HB 2217 HD1 SD1, SB 2295 SD1, and SB 3105 SD1, relating to the Office of Information Practices, and
- c) A bill to eliminate certain powers from the Governor in declaring a state of emergency.
